

The SAQA Florida Region presents a multi-disciplinary collaborative project to celebrate Florida's waters
- as part of the 2021 SAQA Global Conference in St. Petersburg, FL

<u>WHAT?</u> SAQA Florida invites **SAQA members worldwide** to create and **DONATE** 2-D or 3-D textile artworks of fish or other underwater creatures. These works may be in any configuration but **no larger than 12"** in length or width, and may be realistic or imaginary. All works submitted **will** be exhibited at the conference. Backgrounds are okay, but not required. Members are welcome to send more than one piece. Fresh water and salt water creatures are invited.

<u>HOW?</u> SAQA Florida is gathering fish, but turtles, mermaids, and other sea creatures are also welcome. Artwork may be flat, stuffed, embellished, have protruding fins, etc. and does not need to be square or rectangular. We do ask that all edges be finished. **IMPORTANT!** Please include your **name**, **hometown** and state (or country), and **website** on the piece.

<u>WHAT ELSE?</u> Poets (both SAQA and non-SAQA) are invited to submit short works inspired by Florida's underwater fish and other creatures. SAQA Florida Fresh Fish Committee members will select the poetry to be used for the exhibit and a commemorative book.

## AND THEN WHAT?

**Display at the conference**: Textile works and a sampling of the poetry will be built into an installation to be exhibited at the 2021 conference. SAQA Florida will provide the materials and supplies needed to display the work.

**Commemorative Publication**: A book depicting textile artwork and poetry will be created. The SAQA Florida Fresh Fish Committee will choose the best and most diverse selection of textile artwork and poetry to incorporate into this document. The printed book will be soft cover perfect bound, printed through Kindle Direct Publishing and available for sale through Amazon. All costs and royalties from this publication will belong to SAQA Florida.

## **GOALS OF THE PROJECT**

- 1. Highlight Florida's unique aquatic environment to conference attendees.
- 2. Provide a multi-disciplinary creative opportunity for SAQA members.
- 3. Enhance the artistic reputation of SAQA by participating with artists working in other genres.
- 4. Creative fun for participants.
- 5. Raise funds for SAQA Florida Region (proceeds from book sales).
- 6. One other goal is top secret, but it's a great one.
